

NNN WINE UPDATES- RED WINES

2022 Sangiovese \$34 bottle \$12 glass **Texas High Plains** Hoss Fly Vineyards Texas Sangiovese that is fruit forward as its Italian name implies with flavors of cherries, herbs like sage and rosemary.

2021 Cabernet Sauvignon The Lone Star SILVER Winner Intl' Competition 2023 \$36 bottle \$13 glass **Texas High Plains** Moderate weight, good currant and black cherry fruit, with judicious toast and a firm finish with tannins ripe and refined.

2018 Petit Verdot \$34 bottle \$12 glass **Texas High Plains** Barrel aged for 2 years Fruity-yet-floral, with lush tannins, sweet, and spicy, and the finish is extensive, and balanced-in-depth with hints of balsamic and spicy aromas.

2018 Barbera \$36 bottle \$13 glass **Texas High Plains** Barrel aged for 2 years Red cherries, raspberries, subtle fennel, chocolate mint, bright acidity, medium-to-light bodied, soft, well-structured tannins.

Malbec 2019 \$39 bottle \$14 glass **Texas High Plains** 2021 Texas Vinters Cup for Texas Monthly Top 12 Wines in Texas Bold in color and in flavor with plum, spice and cherry characteristics. This medium-to-full-bodied red delivers a punch of rich, lush red and black fruits, with a slight Texas High Plains earthiness.

Sweet Bully Red Wine \$26 bottle \$9 glass **Texas Vineyards** This is a red blend is similar to a light port without the higher alcohol content. This wine is ripe and jammy with explosive flavors of raspberry, plum and cherry for a soft and smooth finish.

2019 Tannat Reserve Wine Club Members \$59 bottle \$19 glass **Texas** Barrel aged for 2+ years Big, masculine wine with red and black fruit flavors of raspberry, plum and blackberry, combined with smoky and spicy notes.

2020 Tannat The Lone Star SILVER Winner Intl' Competition 2023 TexSom GOLD Winner Intl' Competition 2022 \$40 bottle \$14 glass **Texas** Deep color and fruit character, wonderful acidity, that highlights its plum, black cherry, and blackberry fruit flavors.

2021 Negroamaro Lone Star SILVER Winner Intl' Competition 2021 \$39 bottle \$14 glass **Pepper Jack Vineyards Texas High Plains** Has a deep rich color and opens up fruity with cherry, blackberry, rich earthy quality plus hints of tobacco and cocoa.

2022 Nan's Leap \$43 bottle \$15 glass **Texas High Plains- Red Blend** A beautiful dusty plum hue sits in the glass with bursting aromas of black plum and raspberries, floral notes of lilac and rose complemented by hinted of cedar, black tea & slate 60% Cab 20% Cab Franc 15% Malbec 5% Tannat Delicious and Full Bodied.

"IGNATIUS" Tempranillo 2021 The Lone Star BRONZE Winner Intl' Competition 2023 \$38 bottle \$14 glass **Tab Daniel Vineyards Texas High Plains** bottled aged for 2 years Intense flavors of black cherry, raspberry, and starberry lead the aroma while the palate is cloaked in fig flavors and savory notes of clove and new leather.

2021 Montepulciano Rose' The Lone Star GOLD Winner Intl' Competition 2023 TexSom BRONZE Winner Intl' Competition 2022 \$27 bottle \$10 glass **Texas High Plains** This Rosé is gentle, refreshing, light and dry with notes of citrus on the palate. Beautiful peach in color, a great summer wine.

2021 Blanc du Bois The Lone Star SILVER Winner Intl' Competition 2021 \$26 bottle \$9 glass **Texas High Plains** An American hybrid grape demonstrates a floral side of the variety, with potpourri aromas riding over grapefruit.

Bubbly Brut White Wine aka Longhorn Bubbles \$28 bottle \$10 (2 glass minimum) A combination of Viognier and Pinot Grigio, suggests citrus, apple-light bodied, with acidity and delicious apricot, peach and lime flavors.

NanTexan Rose' Bubbles \$29 bottle \$11 (2 glass minimum) **Texas High Plains** Light, sweet bubbles with floral fruity notes that dance around on your tongue. 80% Montepulciano 20% Tempranillo.

Happy Appy Sweet Blanc \$25 bottle \$9 glass **Texas Vineyards** Refreshing and bright, we mixed just the right amount of sweetness to bring out the vibrant aromas of Texas Great Story of '95 Cattle Drive and an appaloosa horse named "Appy"

2020 Roussanne The Lone Star SILVER Winner Intl' Competition 2021 \$28 bottle \$10 glass **Texas High Plains** Rich & complex, with distinct honey, floral and apricot flavors with hints of orange.

2019 DRY Riesling The Lone Star SILVER Winner Intl' Competition 2023 \$26 bottle \$9 glass **Texas High Plains** Flavors of green apple and lime are balanced with subtle tones of minerality with delicate acidity and texture.

2021 Trebbiano 2022 TexSom BRONZE Winner Intl' Competition \$28 bottle \$10 glass **Texas High Plains-Pepper Jack Vineyard** Flavors of wildflowers, tangerine & peach. Fresh dry notes of lemon and green apple.

2022 Picpoul The Lone Star SILVER Winner Intl' Competition 2023 \$29 bottle \$11 glass **Texas High Plains/Loma Vineyards** Brilliant and complex with refreshing fruit and acidity with flavors of lemon, pineapple, and buttery apricot.
